- Understanding Poetic Devices – Challenges in mastering metaphors, similes, rhythm, rhyme, and structure.
- Fear of Judgment – Some students may hesitate to participate due to fear of criticism or lack of confidence.
- Time Constraints – Managing academic workload alongside poetry writing can be challenging.
- Writer's Block – Difficulty in starting or completing a poem due to lack of flow or inspiration.
- Adherence to Theme – Struggling to align their poem with the given competition theme.
- Presentation & Formatting Issues – Uncertainty about proper formatting, length, or submission guidelines.
- Evaluation Subjectivity – Judging poetry is often subjective, which may lead to concerns about fairness.
- Engagement & Participation – Encouraging a large number of students to take part actively.
