Giving is living; Life is meant that we should not just survive, but thrive and help others thrive as well. This is something that the Department of English strongly believes in, and it has led us to want to host a Community Outreach Program to raise awareness of communication skills among schoolchildren. As a result, we met with B.V.Raju Municipal High School, Durgapuram, to obtain permission to host this event.

English communication skills are crucial for everyone, from schoolchildren to employees, but it is especially more important for schoolchildren. The decision to conduct this outreach program in government schools was made because teachers in government schools usually place a greater emphasis on reading and writing than on listening and speaking skills; it is also possible that they are unaware of the importance of language skills or are ill-equipped to do so. As a result, we decided to design an English communication skills awareness program. It is a little encouragement that can spark a great accomplishment.

We held it on April 12, 2022, for 9th grade school children with poor language capabilities. In order to turn these children from confusion to confidence in communication skills and arouse an interest among them to learn language skills, we had our students prepare Litt. Expo. projects on Grammar, i.e., Articles, Prepositions and Tenses; as well as some literary works. On displaying them, degree students, who attended the program one by one taught Litt. Expo project works, made the children involved in the subject, and interacted with them fully.

All the children remained connected and paid attention to all grammatical topics. It was observed that they felt very happy and educated. They raised their queries about how to acquire language skills to the fullest extent possible, and they were given answers.

The Headmaster of the School greeted us warmly. By assigning this assignment to an English teacher, he was able to observe the entire program. He congratulated the entire team for making a great event and encouraged us to do more programs like this in the future.

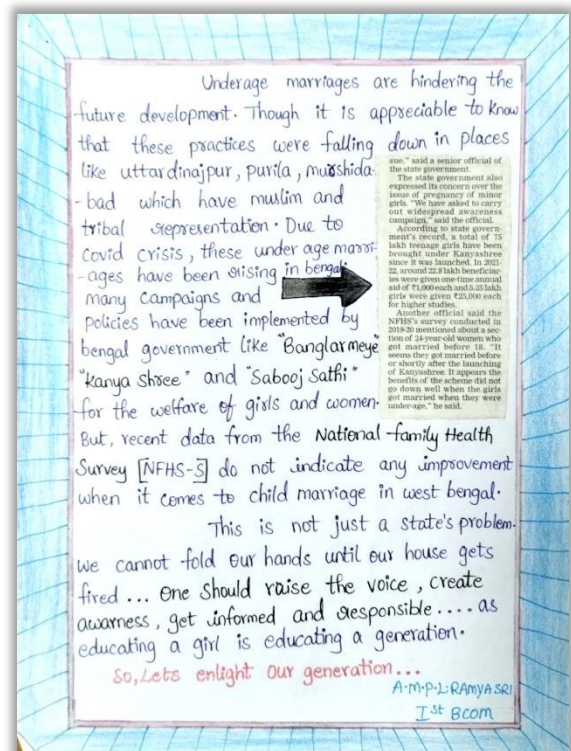
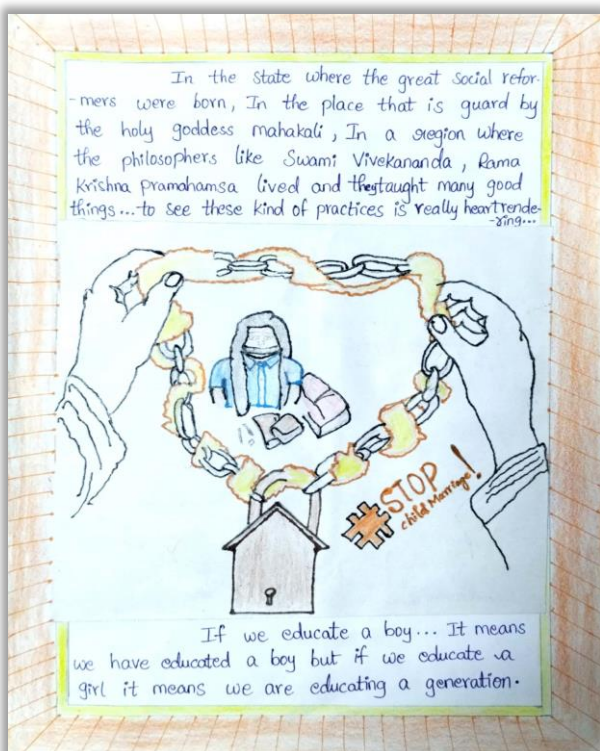
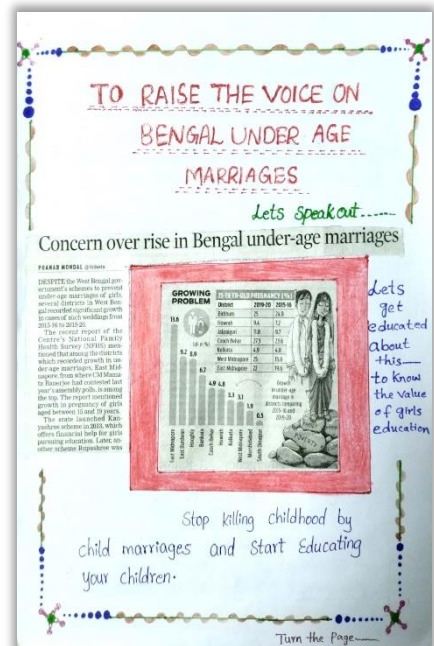
completed on 28th May 2022. In valedictory function, the students those who got the training conveyed their gratitude to the management of Vishnu.

NEWS PAPER ARTICLE WRITING

Writing is a productive skill. For today's employee at an office, writing skills are essential. Undoubtedly, the way we convey our messages, ideas and thoughts decide the career growth of the professionals. Today's students are tomorrow's employees. As a result, we initiated newspaper article writing to the students. It enhances vocabulary building, grammar skills, punctuation development and sentence structure. In this process, students select a news article from newspaper by thorough understanding at first.

Before writing

Students are asked to work in pairs / individual to read and summarize an article that interests them / him / her in their own words. Each pair / individual then reports back to the class about the article they read the same day or the following day. Students also list words or phrases that are not known to them while summarizing newspaper article.

VISUAL PICTORIAL VOCABULARY

Why is English vocabulary important?

We use different words every day to express ideas, thoughts, and feelings to the people around us. Sometimes we communicate successfully and sometimes not. "I didn't mean that!" The mantra of often repeated words or phrases. However, a good vocabulary can help us to express what we actually mean. Vocabulary is the key to learning the English language. Because, without sufficient Vocabulary, students cannot express their ideas or understand others.

Wilkins wrote that "Very little can be expressed without grammar or nothing can be expressed without vocabulary." As students develop greater fluency and expression in English. It is significant for them to acquire more productive English vocabulary knowledge with good learning strategies.

Here are the top 5 reasons why vocabulary is so important:

- **It Improves Reading Comprehension.**
Research has shown that kids need to understand 98% of the words they read to understand what they are reading. Improving vocabulary skills will improve their understanding of novels and textbooks.
- **It's Important to Language Development.**
Children who develop a rich vocabulary tend to be deeper thinkers, express themselves better and read more. Improving language and literacy skills early in life will help them be more successful academically and communicatively.
- **Communicating Ideas.**
Successful communication or "saying what you mean" is dependent upon a good vocabulary base. Using the right words when talking, makes you a more effective communicator.
- **Expressing Yourself in Writing.**
Having a good vocabulary to draw from can help you write more effectively. Students need to use a more formal tone when writing – not conversational language – and to do that, they need a richer vocabulary to tap into those words we don't use when we speak.
- **Occupational Success.**
Researcher Johnson O'Connor found that "a person's vocabulary level is the best single predictor of occupational success."* Success in the business place depends on your communication skills.

VISUAL PICTORIAL VOCABULARY

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RESILIENT

People and things that are resilient are able to recover easily and quickly from unpleasant or damaging events.

Example

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FREELANCER


A person who works as a writer, designer, performer, etc. He sells his work or services by the hour, day, job, etc., rather than receiving a regular wage from one company.

Example

Instead of being employed by only one company, Mahesh works as a freelancer, creating fresh logos for whichever business needs them at the time.

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Alimony

Alimony is money that a court of law orders someone to pay regularly to their former wife or husband after they have got divorced

Example

The law determined that alimony had to be paid to the spouse after an amicable divorce. It was continued for a brief while before coming to an end.

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BLIND SPOT

An area that you are not able to see, especially the part of a road you cannot see when you are driving, behind and slightly to one side of the car.

Example

If a car is in your blind spot while you are driving, it might be extremely dangerous. This causes the majority of vehicle collisions.

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Arbitrage

The practice of buying something from one place and selling it almost immediately in another place where it is worth more

Example

Vendors at the fair use arbitrage opportunities, buying Chinese toys for a few cents and selling them at a much higher dollar amount.

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Leapfrogging

To improve your position by going past other people quickly or by missing out some stages.

Example

He leapfrogged from fifth to first position pasting several senior colleagues to attain to CEO post.

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
